MAYAN MYSTERIES: TIKAL & YAXHÁ

Day 1. Arrival at Mundo Maya Airport in Flores, Petén. Transfer to the most important archaeological site of the Mayan world, Tikal. Visit to Complex Q and R, followed by

the Central Acropolis, Temple I "The Great Jaguar," and Temple II "Temple of the Masks." Visit to the Lost World. In the afternoon, return to the Visitor Center for lunch. At the appropriate time, transfer to the hotel.

Day 2. Breakfast at the hotel. Departure at 9:00 a.m. Transfer to Flores Island to board a boat that will take us to ARCAS, a wildlife rescue and rehabilitation center, where we can observe endangered species. We will then board the boat again to continue the journey with a visit to the Tayasal Peninsula, where our guide will provide further information about the Stone Horse. We continue across Lake Petén Itzá to the Santa Bárbara Museum, where archaeological pieces found on Flores Island are exhibited. Afterwards, we return to Flores Island for a walking tour, where we will see some stelae from the Postclassic period. Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel.



Day 3. At the scheduled time, departure to the Archaeological Site of Yaxhá. Arrival at Yaxhá, an ancient ceremonial center and city of the pre-Columbian Mayan civilization. The site shows evidence of Teotihuacan influence in its architecture and stelae. Here, we can see the only set of Twin Pyramids outside of Tikal, also known as the Plaza of the Stelae. Lunch. At the appropriate time, return to your hotel.

Day 4. Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, transfer to Mundo Maya Airport for your return flight to the city.
